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
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KOLEKCIJA VUGRINEC


Zbirka Davorja Vugrinec je svoj krst doživila v zagrebškem Umetniškem paviljonu leta 2015, kjer so jo predstavili kot zbirko „mojstrovin hrvaške moderne“. Je sijajen primer zbirateljske ambicije, ki presega celo muzejske zbirke in nazorno kaže, kateri dejavniki sestavljajo uspešno zbiralno politiko. Izbor za razstavo vključuje umetnine, ki so jih ustvarili sopotniki, prijatelji in študijski kolegi slovenskih umetnikov, od Šubicev, Ažbeta, do impresionistov, še posebej zgovorno pa je predstavljeno obdobje oblikovanja „zagrebške šole“ po ustanovitvi tamkajšnje likovne akademije, ki je po sredini dvajsetih let 20. stoletja postala šola slovenskim umetnikom. Na razstavo je vključenih petinštideset slik in dvanajst kipov, dela umetnikov, kot so Mato Celestin Medović, Vlaho Bukovac, Emanuel Vidović, Menci Clement Crnčić, Bela Čikoš Sesija, Mirko Rački, Ljubo Babić, Miroslav Kraljević, Milivoj Uzelac, Marjan Trepše, Vilko Gecan, Vladimir Becić, Marino Tartaglia, Omer Mujadžić, Ivan Meštrović, Frano Kršinić idr. Zbirko je oblikoval Davor Vugrinec, ki je najboljši strelec vseh časov v hrvaški nogometni ligi. Odličnost njegove zbirke je primerljiva z odličnostjo njegove poklicne kariere.

THE VUGRINEC COLLECTION

The collection of Davor Vugrinec was presented for the first time to the public in 2015 at the Art Pavilion in Zagreb as the collection of “masterpieces of Croatian Modernism”. As a demonstration of the requirements that make up a successful collecting policy, the collection is an excellent example of ambitious determination that surpasses even some museum collections. The exhibition will present contemporaries, friends, and fellow students of Slovenian artists, from the Šubic brothers, Anton Ažbe, and the Impressionists onwards. Especially storied is the founding era of the “Zagreb School” after the establishment of the art academy there which became a destination for Slovenian artists after the mid-1920s. The exhibition of sixtyfive paintings and works on paper and twelve sculptures includes works by Mato Celestin Medović, Vlaho Bukovac, Emanuel Vidović, Menci Clement Crnčić, Bela Čikoš Sesija, Mirko Rački, Ljubo Babić, Miroslav Kraljević, Milivoj Uzelac, Marjan Trepše, Vilko Gecan, Vladimir Becić, Marino Tartaglia, Omer Mujadžić, Ivan Meštrović, Frano Kršinić and others. The collection was assembled by Davor Vugrinec, the scoring champion of all times in the Croatian Football League. The quality of Vugrinec’s collection matches his career achievement.
